

Geneva Historical Society Adopt An Artifact Program

The artifacts in our archival and three-dimensional collections are the core of Geneva's history. Through these objects Geneva Historical Society tells the stories of the people, businesses and events in Geneva and surrounding area.

Entrusted in our care are 1,300 cubic feet of archival materials, 50,000 photographs and 7,000 objects. We, however, only have enough space to display roughly 3% of our collections at any given time. The rest of our artifacts are kept in storage, but even there they need protection and care to preserve them for the future.

To help us care for our collections, we are offering the opportunity to adopt an artifact. What do you get when you adopt an artifact?
